I.A. No.1/2026 (Application under Order VI Rule 17 CPC)

Application under order VI Rule 17 CPC has been filed by the plaintiff. The plaintiff also amend para 3,9,10, and 11 of the plaint to give better particulars regarding default in invoices, cause of action and limitation of the suit. The amended plaint has been filed along with application. It is submitted by the counsel for plaintiff that no fresh cause of action has been incorporated in the application and there are no material changes affecting a previous cause of action. The amendments have been necessitated on account of lack of better particulars.

Heard and perused the application.

The amendments sought by the plaintiff are of clarificatory nature and do not change the cause of action. The suit of the plaintiff is still at its initial stages and no prejudice shall be caused to the defendant, if the amendments are allowed. Accordingly, the application filed by plaintiff is allowed. Amended plaint along with the amended Statement of Truth is taken on record. Application stands disposed off accordingly.

I.A. No. 2/2026 (application under Order XI Rule 1 (5) CPC for placing on record additional documents)

Plaintiff has filed application under Order XI Rule 1 (5) CPC for placing on record additional documents i.e. ledger account of the defendant's Haryana business, screen shot of WhatsApp communication of plaintiff and accountant of

defendant dated 29.04.2026 and certificate under Section 63 of BSA, in support of the WhatsApp communication. It has been stated that these documents could not be filed earlier on account of bonafide mistake.

Perusal of record shows that suit of the plaintiff is at initial stages and summons have not been issued. Application is allowed and documents are taken on record. Application stands disposed off accordingly.

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I have perused the plaint and documents.

Issue summons of the suit to the defendant by all permissible modes including electronic modes on filing of PF/RC/Speed Post/Courier/WhatsApp/Email. Plaintiff shall also file the PDF of the complete set of paper book to be served along with the summons electronically. Steps be taken within a week from today.
