Affidavit of the respondent has been filed and copy has been supplied. One report from the Chief Secretary, Health Department, Bihar has also been received by this tribunal and the same has been perused.

In view of facts stated in the said report, serious doubts have been created about genuineness of the disability report earlier produced by the petitioner before this tribunal in which her disability percentage is found to be given 40%. It has also been reported that the petitioner was called again and again to be present before the board/ committee constituted for re-assessment of her disability, but she failed to appear as she is not found to be residing at the given address and her house is lying locked for the last more than 10 years. The above report also shows that an explanation stands already called from the Civil Surgeon Jamui, Bihar by the Deputy Commissioner concerned vide his letter no. 1099 (18) dated 12.07.2019 as to how the above disability certificate to petitioner was issued when she has already left her village more than 10 years back.

In view of the above, put up on **05.09.2019** for further proceedings/recording evidence of respondent as one regular stenographer is on leave today and no substitute stenographer has been provided and even Ahlmad is on leave.

Petitioner is also directed to be present in person on the date fixed for her examination regarding financial needs and further proceedings.

Let fresh notice be also issued through SHO concerned to the Principal Secretary, Bihar concerned calling a report about fate of the show cause notice dated 12.07.2019 served upon the Civil Surgeon concerned.
