### **O R D E R**

***(Delivered on the 11<sup>th</sup> day of the month of August, of the year  
2026)***

This order shall dispose off an application at Exhibit C-1  
for bail u/s 480 of BNS.

2. It is the case of the applicant that he has been arrested by  
the respondent in crime No. 82/2026 under Section 331(3) and  
305 of BNS. It is stated that the applicant is innocent and that he  
has been manipulated and has been arrested without any  
justification and that the applicant has been falsely implicated in  
the present crime. Hence, it is prayed that bail be granted.

3. The Officer endorsed his say stating that the remand be  
considered as say as the applicant was produced with the Judicial

Custody remand.

4. As seen in remand which is considered as say in the present bail application that ground for objection is that the nature of present crime is serious in nature and required to be investigated thoroughly and that the accused person's criminal antecedent has to be checked at the local Police Station to understand his involvement in other crimes.

5. Perused the remand application and say and heard Ld. Advocate Mr. S. Naik for the Applicant and Ld. A.P.P. Mr. M. Naik for the State.

6. Now, admittedly the applicant's remand sought being for judicial custody, there is no any valid ground for rejection of bail. As objections raised for rejecting the bail can be taken care of by imposing conditions.

7. Therefore, considering the circumstances herein, I am inclined to allow the present application, subject to the terms and conditions mentioned herein below.

8. Hence, in view of above, I pass the following:-

The Applicant is granted bail in Crime No. 82/2026 Vasco Police Station subject to the following terms and conditions:

- a. The Applicant shall furnish a personal bond of ₹ 15,000/- (Rupees fifteen thousand only) and a surety of the like amount and to the satisfaction of the court.
- b. The Applicant shall furnish his detailed permanent/local address along with proof and contact numbers to this court.
- c. The Applicant shall furnish detail address proof and contact number of surety to this Court and the Investigating Officer to verify the address proof and report.
- d. The applicant shall not commit any offence similar to the offence of which he is presently charged.
- e. The applicant shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of this case so as to dissuade

him/her from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer.

f. The Applicant shall not leave the State of Goa and the Country without the prior permission of the Court.

g. The Applicant to appear before the Investigating Officer as and when directed till the filing of the charge-sheet

The applicant shall be released only if not required in any other crime and after scrupulously observing the above mentioned conditions.

This order be mailed to the Jailor.
