Reply to the application for restoration of the appeal has not been filed yet.

This appeal was dismissed in default vide order dated 02.02.2026 as none could appear on behalf of the appellant on the said date. It is mentioned in the application that due to the bonafide mistake, Ld. Counsel noted a wrong date of hearing as 03.02.2026 due to which none could appear and appeal was dismissed in default.

Ld. Counsel for the applicant has placed on record a copy of his case diary to show that the date was noted as 03.02.2026.

The instant application is filed on 06.02.2026 i.e. within a reasonable time from 03.02.2026, when the appeal was dismissed.
