ORDER.

1. This is an anticipatory bail moved on behalf of applicant/accused Balwinder Kumar alias Tali in case FIR NO.184 dated 1.11.2018, under Section 61/1/14 of Punjab Excise Act, P.S Dinanagar

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2. On 13.11.2018, this Court granted interim relief to applicant/accused by passing following order:-

1....“ This is an anticipatory bail moved on behalf of applicant/accused Balwinder Kumar alias Tali in case FIR NO.184 dated 1.11.2018, under Section 61/1/14 of Punjab Excise Act, P.S Dinanagar

- Brief facts of the case are that on 1.11.2018 applicant/accused was found in possession of 120 bottles of illicit liquor without any permit or license.
- Contention of Sh. Narinder Kumar, Adv, Ld. Counsel for applicants/accused is that applicant/accused has been falsely implicated in the present case. As per prosecution case, applicant/accused fled away from the spot and the recovery has been affected from the applicant/accused. Identity of applicant/accused is in dispute. He argued that applicant/accused is ready to join investigation and co operate with the Investigating Agency.
- Adjourned to 26.11.2018
- Accordingly, in the meantime applicant/accused is directed to join investigation and cooperate with

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the IO. In the event of arrest of applicant/accused, he is ordered to be released on interim bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of IO/Arresting Officer, subject to conditions laid down Under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C..

3. Today HC Harjinder Singh came present to record his statement to the effect that applicant/accused has joined investigation and his custody is not required in the present case.
4. In view of this, interim order dated 13.11.2018 whereby applicant/accused was ordered to be released on interim bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of IO/Arresting Officer, subject to conditions laid down Under Section 438(2) Cr.P., is hereby made absolute.
5. Police record be returned and file be consigned to record room.
