Due to outbreak of Covid 19 pandemic, the functioning of District Courts has been suspended w.e.f. 23.03.2020 to 31.07.2020 by the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi vide order (s) dated 23.03.2020, 25.03.2020, 15.04.2020, 02.05.2020, 16.05.2020, 29.05.2020, 13.06.2020, 29.06.2020 and 14.07.2020.

In compliance of the said orders, the present matters were adjourned enbloc on 09.04.2020, 08.05.2020 and 30.06.2020 for today as only urgent matters and cases fixed for final arguments were being taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

However, now in view of the directions contained in letter No. 26/DHC/2020 dated 30.07.2020 of the Hon'ble Delhi High Court, the operation of which now stands extended till 31.08.2020 vide letter no. 322/RG/DHC/2020 dated 15.08.2020, all the matters are to be taken up for hearing through video conferencing except the matters fixed for evidence (excluding ex-parte evidence where evidence may be recorded on affidavit).

An application under Section 151 CPC moved on behalf of R-3 seeking deletion of their name is already on record and notices were directed to be issued to the opposite parties. However, it is not clear if the notices have been sent or not. **Let fresh e-notices be issued to them through Nazarat Branch for the next date of hearing.**

Since these matters are fixed for evidence, they are again being adjourned to **28.10.2020** for the same purpose.
