Case received by way of transfer. It be registered. Today case was fixed for awaiting RC.

RC not filed. Postal receipt of RC was already filed, as per which period of 30 days has already been elapsed from the date of issuing RC. Complainant submitted that accused is not intentionally turning up on the court despite knowledge of the pendency of the present criminal complaint against him. He further submitted that the accused has been approaching the complainant for settlement. In view of submission made by the complainant this court is satisfied that accused is intentionally not turning up in the court despite knowledge of pendency of the present complaint against him. Therefore, this court is of the view that in order to procure the presence of accused in coercive method is required to be adopted. Therefore, Bailable warrants to the sum of Rs.5000/- with one surety in the like amount against accused be issued for 21.11.2026. Complainant is permitted to accompany the serving constable in execution of bailable warrants upon the accused.
