It is submitted by Ld. Counsel for the defendant that written statement has been filed by him however legible copy of some of the documents filed by the plaintiff along with plaint have not yet been supplied to him.

Vakalatnama is filed on behalf of the plaintiff.

Submissions of Ld. Counsel for the defendant are highly opposed by Ld. Counsel for the plaintiff.

It is submitted by Ld. Counsel for the plaintiff that Ld. Counsel for the defendant has not made any communication with the plaintiff for supply of the legible copies of the relevant documents. It is further submitted by him today the submissions regarding supply of legible copies of documents are made only to gain time as written statement is not filed by the defendant within 30 days of receiving of the copy of plaint and the documents.

Record reveals that on 14.05.2025 copies of relevant documents were supplied by Ld. Counsel for the plaintiff and the submissions were made by Ld. Counsel for the defendant that he has now received the entire set of documents.

Considering the order dated 14.05.2025 the submissions of Ld. Counsel for the defendant made today are not found acceptable.

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At this stage it is pointed out by Ld. Counsel for the defendant that an application under Order 8 Rule 9 r/w Section 151 CPC mentioning all the facts and circumstances was filed in between the dates.

Let copy of the above mentioned application as well as copy of written statement be supplied to Ld. Counsel for the plaintiff within 15 days.

To come up for further proceedings on 17.03.2026.

Interim order, if any, to continue till the next date of hearing.
