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**ORDER:-**

1. Heard on the bail application moved under Section 437 Cr.P.C by the accused/applicant Gurdev Singh @ Rubal. It is averred in the application that the accused/applicant has surrendered before this Court on 15.01.2018 and remanded to judicial custody on 16.01.2018. It is averred that applicant/accused is innocent and nothing has been recovered from him and alleged recovery if any is false and fabricated. The name of the applicant/accused has been falsely put into the episode on the statement of co-accused. The applicant/accused is no longer required by the police for further investigation. It is averred that accused undertakes that he will not abscond or tamper with prosecution evidence and will not leave India without prior permission of the Court, if released on bail and prayer is made that the application in hand be allowed.
2. Notice of bail application was issued to the APP for the State, who vehemently opposed the same.
3. I have heard the Ld. Counsel for the accused/applicant as well as Ld. APP for the State on the present bail application. Police record has also perused. From the perusal of the same, it reveals that stolen

motorcycle was recovered from the possession of co-accused and accused/ applicant is in custody since 16.01.2018 and as such no useful purpose would be served by detaining the accused behind the bars, as presentation of challan and conclusion of trial will take sufficient time. Moreover, it will be burden on the State exchequer. Accordingly, the present application for bail of applicant/accused is allowed and accused is ordered to be released on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds in the sum of Rs.25,000/- with one surety in the like amount. Papers be attached with the main file.
