1. Fresh vakalatnama has been filed by Mr. Praveen Suri for defendants. Same is taken on record.
2. As per report received, defendants were first served with the summons with complete paper book through email on 28.11.2025. Thereafter, they were further served physically on 05.12.2025. In the meantime, they were also served through WhatsApp on 30.11.2025. For the purpose of computation of limitation, first date of service shall be taken into account, which was 28.11.2025.
3. The stipulated time period of 30 days from date of service was already over on 28.12.2025. Otherwise also, period even if counted from 05.12.2025 is already over. Till date no WS has been filed on behalf of defendants. There is no application for seeking extension of time and I have no ground to presume any reason for defendants, in order to extend the time limit as provided under VIII Rule 1 CPC.
4. In the morning, while appearing through V/C, ld. counsel for defendants had raised contention that he was not supplied copy of map and he was told that at least the copies received by defendants could have been produced before court, to show what was actually received. He has appeared and has shown the copy of paper book received by defendants, which has copy of map as well. So I do not find any merit in such contention raised by Mr.

Suri. In these circumstances, opportunity to file Written Statement stands closed.

5. Put up on 13.03.2026, for arguments on application under Order XV-A CPC, which was filed along with plaint. Reply to the same may be filed but with advance copy being sent to ld. counsel for plaintiff.
