1. Vide my separate order of even date, announced in the open court today, I have passed ex-parte injunction order and have also appointed one Local Commissioner. Copy of orders be provided dasti to ld. counsel for plaintiffs.
2. A copy of said order be also sent to the Local Commissioner, along with a court notice, seeking consent and confirmation of acceptance of the assignment within two days. The email ID of this Court be mentioned over that Court notice with endorsement that consent and confirmation can be communicated through email as well.
3. Compliance report under Order XXXIX Rule 3 CPC shall be filed by the plaintiff within 24 hours of completion of the execution of the commission, in the form of affidavit.
4. Ld. counsel also pressed for masking of the particulars of the parties

citing a practice directions issued by Hon'ble High Court of Delhi.

5. I have perused the said practice directions no.139/Rules/DHC dated 27.05.2025. In view of directions given therein, the Computer Branch, Patiala House Court, New Delhi, is directed to mask the name of parties to this suit in all the informations appearing on the website and otherwise, till further orders.
6. Copy of this order be sent immediately to the Incharge, Computer Branch, Patiala House Court, New Delhi, for compliance.
7. Summons for settlement of issues be issued to the defendants by all permissible modes i.e. through DTDC courier/E-mail/WhatsApp on filing of PF and soft copy of complete paper book of the suit in PDF format. For service through electronic mode i.e. email ID and WhatsApp number, AR of plaintiffs to file affidavit with respect to the correctness of the mobile number and email id. Process be filed within seven working days. Copy of the plaint, along with the entire paper book shall be served upon the defendants. The summons shall indicate that the written statement must be filed within thirty days from the date of receipt of the summons, and that alongwith written statement, defendants shall also file affidavit/statement of admission/denial of the documents filed by the plaintiffs as per Order XI CPC as amended by the Commercial Courts Act, 2015. Advance copy of the same shall be supplied to plaintiffs or their counsel.
