Accused Buta Singh produced from JC represented by Sh. Yogesh Saxena, learned counsel for accused.

Accused Darbara Singh @ Billa and Ajay @ Sandeep Singh are produced in J.C.

Accused Darbara Singh @ Billa and Ajay @ Sandeep Singh are not represented by any advocate and they have been intimated about their rights to be represented by an advocate free of costs to which they have replied in affirmative. In the circumstances, Sh. Brijesh Oberoi, learned advocate, enrollment no D-4/97 Chamber No. 391, Lawyers Chamber, PHC, New Delhi-11001, Mobile No. 9810281212, who is present in the court is appointed as amicus curiae to represent both the accused persons in the present case.

Heard and record perused.

As per the allegations in the charge sheet, accused Darbara Singh @ Billa and Ajay @ Sandeep Singh while coming to Mohan Garden, Uttam Nagar, Delhi in Alto car bearing no. PB 32 U 5513 brought large quantity of heroin. 1.5 kilograms heroin was seized from the possession of accused Darbara Singh @ Billa, One kilogram heroin was seized from the possession of accused Ajay @ Sandeep Singh and 1.5 kilogram heroin was also seized from the above said car bearing no. PB 32 U 5513. Thereafter on the disclosure of accused persons their another associate Buta Singh was also arrested.

There are sufficient material to take cognizance for the offences punishable under section 21,22 and 29 of NDPS Act against all the three accused persons. Accordingly, cognizance of offences is taken against them.

IO submits that e-challan has already been filed along with the charge sheet.

Copy of charge sheet as well as e-challan be supplied to the accused

persons against proper receipt. Matter is adjourned for scrutiny of documents and further proceedings on 06.11.2017.

At this stage accused Butta Singh has moved an application for grant of parole for mediological purpose. Let a report be called from the Jail Supdt about the medical health and treatment provided to applicant/accused for date fixed.

Put up on date fixed for purpose fixed.
