

BA 3008 of 2018 Harish Kumar Vs State

1. This is an anticipatory bail moved on behalf of applicant/accused Harish in case FIR NO.185 dated 1.11.2018, under Section 61/1/14 of Punjab Excise Act, P.S Dinanagar
2. Brief facts of the case are that on 1.11.2018 applicant/accused was found in possession of 120 bottles of illicit liquor without any permit or license.
3. Contention of Sh. Narinder Kumar, Adv, Ld. Counsel for applicants/accused is that applicant/accused has been falsely implicated in the present case. Applicant/accused was not apprehended at the spot. Recovery has been affected from the applicant/accused. Identity of applicant/accused is also in dispute. He argued that applicant/accused is ready to join investigation and co operate with the Investigating Agency.
4. Adjourned to 26.11.2018
6. Accordingly, in the meantime applicant/accused is directed to join investigation and cooperate with the IO. In the event of arrest of applicant/accused, he is ordered to be released on interim bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of IO/Arresting Officer, subject to conditions laid down Under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
