One rectified plaint has been presented today without any hand made additions and accordingly same was perused.

Plaintiff has sought recovery of some unpaid amount by the defendant on the basis of service provided by plaintiff to the defendant. However, plaint is silent in respect of the invoices raised by plaintiff against the defendant. It merely refers to some mutual current account, which cannot be sufficient pleading. Plaintiff has given one liner pleading regarding limitation, which is also insufficient to help the court to assess the limitation.

Plaintiff is directed to plead all the relevant facts, be it in respect of invoices, be it in respect of calculation of interest by showing complete calculation of interest and be it describing limitation aspect or other aspect. Fresh amended plaint with fresh Statement of Truth be filed up to next date.
