Ld. Counsel for respondent no. 3 submits that he will take instructions from Mr. Prem Kumar on whether he is aware of the contact details of Mr. Vipin Kumar.

An application under Order 6 Rule 17 r/w Section 151 CPC is filed alongwith copy of death certificate and no objection certificate of Smt. Sapna.

It is submitted by Ld. Counsel for the legal representatives of the petitioner that the petitioner has died.

It is submitted that due to the motor accident, Mr. Pawan had died and the petitioner was his father.

It is submitted that the legal representatives stated in the application under consideration are two sisters and one brother of Mr.

Pawan. It is submitted that Mr. Pawan was unmarried and his mother has also died.

It is submitted that the two sisters and the brother are the only surviving legal representatives of Mr. Pawan and the petitioner Mr. Suresh.

It is submitted that the legal representative Smt. Sapna, sister of Mr. Pawan has relinquished her share in favour of the other two legal representatives and in this regard, affidavit-cum-no objection certificate of Smt. Sapna has been filed.

Application is not opposed.

Application is allowed.

Smt. Shippi and Mr. Mohit are brought on record as the petitioners in the present case.

Let a fresh amended memo of parties be filed incorporating the name of Mr. Vipin as respondent no. 2 and of Mr. Prem Kumar as respondent no. 3.
