Heard upon application moved by the applicant/accused for releasing him on bail for the offence under Sections 21/61/85 of NDPS Act on the ground that he is in judicial custody in this case since 1.1.2019, notice of which was given to the APP for the State who argued that accused has committed serious offence and the application may please be dismissed. Perusal of file, it reveals that accused is in custody since 1.1.2019. Recovery effected from the accused is small quantity. Presentation of challan and trial of the case is likely to take time and no useful purpose would be served by keeping the accused behind bar for indefinite period. Therefore, above mentioned accused/ applicant is ordered to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds in the sum of ₹ 30,000/- with one surety in the like amount. Bail/surety bonds not furnished.
