

Jaspreet Singh Vs. State of Punjab

The instant bail application has been filed for releasing of accused Jaspreet Singh on bail on the ground that he has been falsely implicated in this case. Notice of the present bail application was issued to APP for the State, who opposed the present bail application. Arguments on the bail application heard. Accused is in judicial custody since the date from his arrest. Conclusion of the trial will take long time, so no useful purpose would be served by keeping the accused in custody for an unlimited period. As such accused Jaspreet Singh is ordered to be released on bail on furnishing his bail bonds in the sum of Rs. 1 lac with two sureties of the like amount with the following conditions:-

- 1 He will appear on each and every date of hearing in the court.
- 2 He will not leave the country without prior permission of the court.
- 3 He will not allured the prosecution witnesses nor tamper the investigation of the prosecution.

Bail and surety bonds not furnished. Papers be attached with the main file/remand papers.
