

7 EX 84/25 REWATI GERA Vs. AJAY KUMAR AND ORS

JD-1 & 2 with Ld. Counsel Mr. Madan Lal.

Ld. Counsel for the JD- 1 & 2 submitted that he has filed objections on 27.03.2026. The objections are not found on record.

Ld. Counsel for the DH submitted that even he has not received the copy of the same.

JDs are directed to trace the objections and place it on record.

It is noted that Ld. Counsel for the JDs filed an application for stay of the proceedings on 13.04.2026. Copy of the same already supplied.

Ld. Counsel for the DH submitted that the said application is not maintainable as JDs have not challenged the exparte judgement and decree dated 23.12.2022.

At this stage, Ld. Counsel for the JDs submitted that one month time be granted to the JDs so that they will approach the concerned court in Chhabra, District Bara Rajasthan to move an appropriate application for setting aside the exparte judgment and decree dated 23.12.2022. Heard.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, JDs are granted time to move appropriate application before the concerned court within a month. Aforesaid application is disposed of accordingly.

At this stage, Ld. Counsel for the DH seeks time to move an application under Order 21 Rule 66 r/w Section 151 CPC. Let the needful be done.
