AWARD

1. The present matter and the criminal case have been settled between the claimant and respondent no. 1 for a total sum of Rs.50,000/-(Rupees Fifty Thousand only) in full and final

settlement of claim amount. Joint statement of claimant and respondent no. 1 have been recorded in this regard.

2. In view of statements made, an award in the sum of Rs.50,000/-(Rupees Fifty Thousand only) in favour of the claimant and against respondents is passed towards full and final settlement of claim of the claimant for compensation in respect of injuries suffered by her in the accident, which is subject matter of present DAR arising out of FIR no.379/25, under Sections 281/125B BNS & 3/181 MV Act, PS Vasant Kunj South.

3. It has been agreed between the claimant and respondent no. 1 that Rs.25,000/- will be paid by respondent no.1 to the claimant within a month from today and the second installment of Rs.25,000/- will be paid before the criminal court on 29.09.2026.

4. Respondent no. 1 is directed to pay both installments on time, failing which it is liable to pay interest at the rate of 9% per annum for the period of delay.

5. A copy of this award be given to the parties free of cost and be sent by email. Ahlmad is directed to send the copy of the award to the concerned Judicial Magistrate and Delhi Legal Services Authority, New Delhi District in view of Judgment titled as Rajesh Tyagi Vs. Jaibir Singh & Ors. passed in FAO no.842/2003 dated 12.12.2014.

6. Further, Nazir is directed to maintain the record in Form XVIII as per the directions given by the Hon'ble Delhi High Court in Rajesh Tyagi's case on 08.01.2021.
