Perusal of record reflects that this is the third application under Section 483 BNSS seeking grant of regular bail. The applicant/accused has mentioned that the last application was dismissed by this Court vide order dated 22.04.2025 passed by the Ld. Predecessor of this Court.

There is no mention of the grounds as to why the last bail application was dismissed. There is no mention of the grounds of dismissal of first bail application.

The Ld. Counsel for the applicant/accused has raised the ground of parity of co-accused persons, however, no details of the bail orders of the said accused persons is mentioned in the present application and no such order is accompanied.

The present bail application has been filed in most casual manner and same is in teeth of the directions of Hon'ble

Supreme Court of India in ***Kusha Daruka Vs. The State of Odisha***” in CrI. Appeal No. 303/2024 decided on 19.01.2024

The the present application is nothing but gross misrepresentation of the facts.

Ld. Counsel for applicant/accused wishes to withdraw present application with liberty to file afresh. Separate statement of the Ld. Counsel is recorded to the said effect. The application is hereby disposed off as withdrawn.
