

NCB Vs Maria Laura BalcazarZabala & Others

Fresh complaint filed on behalf of the NCB. Let it be checked and registered.

Present: Sh. P.C. Aggarwal, Ld. SPP for NCB.

IO Sh. Vikas Yadav in person.

E-challan filed.

Perused the complaint.

It has been alleged in the complaint filed that on 13.06.2017 on the basis of secret information, accused Maria Laura BalcazarZabala was intercepted at Hotel Bloom Rooms, Paharganj, New Delhi alongwith 2.5 kgs of cocaine and accused namely Michael Azubuike and Michael Onyebuchi were also intercepted outside aforesaid hotel when they came to the Hotel for the purpose of receiving the recovered contraband. From the record, it reveals that accused Maria Laura BalcazarZabala arrived at India from Addis Ababa. The sample of the substance was sent to CRCL and as per the report of CRCL, same was found positive for cocaine.

In the considered opinion of this Court, the material on record is sufficient to take cognizance of the offences punishable U/s 21, 23 & 29 of NDPS Act. Hence, cognizance is so taken. Copies of the complaint and documents be supplied to all accused. Copy of E-challan be also supplied.

This complaint has been filed by a public servant Sh. Vikas Yadav, IO in discharge of his duties. He has moved an application for dispensing with his preliminary examination and for his exemption from personal appearance for future dates on the ground that he remains busy in official duties and it is not possible for him to attend the court on each and every date of hearing and that he be therefore allowed to be represented through the Special PP. In view of the submissions made, the preliminary examination of the complainant is dispensed with and he is exempted from personal appearance during trial.

To come up for appearance of all accused/further proceedings on 11.12.2017 (date already fixed).
