Ram Kumar Vs. Kartar Singh & Ors.

Due to outbreak of Covid 19 pandemic, the functioning of District Courts has been suspended w.e.f. 23.03.2020 to 31.07.2020 by the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi vide order (s) dated 23.03.2020, 25.03.2020, 15.04.2020, 02.05.2020, 16.05.2020, 29.05.2020, 13.06.2020, 29.06.2020 and 14.07.2020.

In compliance of the said orders, the present matter was adjourned en-bloc on 21.04.2020 and 12.06.2020 for today as only urgent matters and cases fixed for final arguments were being taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

However, now in view of the directions contained in letter No. 26/DHC/2020 dated 30.07.2020 of the Hon'ble Delhi High Court, all the matters are to be taken up for hearing through video conferencing except the matters fixed for evidence (excluding ex-parte evidence where evidence may be recorded on affidavit).

Hence, the matter has accordingly been taken up today. However, none for other parties has joined the proceedings through video conferencing despite the fact that URL link of this Court has already been put on the official website of this Court. Hence, it is being adjourned to **24.09.2020** for the same purpose.
