Perused complaint, verification of the complainant, documents filed on record. Heard Ld. Advocate for the complainant. I have gone through the entire prima-facie evidence on record. Moreover, report of police after detail investigation/inquiry vide section 202 of the Cr.P.C. also shows reasonable possible commission of alleged offence by the accused. The complainant approached before the court against alleged grievance, it wont be fair and just to discard such complaint on oath directly. Whether the alleged offence is committed or not would be decided after due procedure of trial and opportunity to both the sides. But as far as order of issue process is concern I find that, prima-facie case seems to be committed by the accused for the offence punishable under section 447, 385, 323, 504, 506 r.w. 34 of the Indian Penal Code. Hence, the order.

ORDER

Process be issued against accused for the offence punishable under section 447, 385, 323, 504, 506 r.w. 34 of the Indian Penal Code vide section 204 of the Criminal Procedure Code.
