REASONS

Accused No.1 has sent an application for pleading guilty from jail on e-mail. He is produced before me through V.C. Charge is framed against him, to which he voluntarily pleaded guilty. The accused is in jail since 18.05.2025. Heard both the accused in person. He has submitted that,

lenient view may be taken as he is the only earning member of his family. Considering the nature of offence, antecedents of accused, age of accused and the period of detention already undergone, pass following order :-

ORDER

- i) Accused No. 1. **Firoz @ Arbaz Mohd. Shakil Shaikh** is convicted under section 241 of Criminal Procedure Code for the offence punishable u/sec. 305 r/w 3(5) of **Bhartiya Nyay Sanhita** and he is sentenced to suffer R.I. for 6 (Six) months.
- ii) Accused No. 1. **Firoz @ Arbaz Mohd. Shakil Shaikh** is convicted under section 241 of Criminal Procedure Code for the offence punishable u/sec. 331(2) r/w 3(5) of **Bhartiya Nyay Sanhita** and He is sentenced to suffer R.I. for 6 (Six) months.
- iii) Accused No. 1. **Firoz @ Arbaz Mohd. Shakil Shaikh** is convicted under section 241 of Criminal Procedure Code for the offence punishable u/sec. 331(4) r/w 3(5) of **Bhartiya Nyay Sanhita** and He is sentenced to suffer R.I. for 6 (Six) months.
- iv) All the sentences shall run concurrently.
- v) Accused is in custody since 18.05.2025. He is entitled to get benefit of set off for the period of detention already undergone vide under section 428 of Cr.P.C.
- vi) The seized muddemal be preserved for trial of accused No. 2 & 3.
- vii) Copy of this judgment be supplied to accused No.1 free of cost.
