1. This is the bail application u/s 483 of BNSS filed on behalf of the applicant/accused Anuj.

2. It is submitted by Ld. counsel for the applicant/accused that perusal of the FIR would show that accused/applicant Anuj was alone while on complainant's side, three persons were there. It is not possible that a single person would be able to beat three persons. It is further submitted that there is prior enmity between the parties and there is a motive to file the present case. It is further submitted that there are cross cases between the parties. Further, no bail is pending before the Hon'ble Delhi High Court.

3. On the other hand, it is submitted by Ld. counsel for the complainant/victim that accused got a false FIR registered against the complainant due to prior enmity between them. It is further submitted that both the parties reside in the same locality

and there is possibility that accused/applicant might threaten the complainant. It is further submitted that accused has violent behaviour.

4. I have heard both the sides and gone through the record.

5. As per MLC of Muneeb Kumar, he received a lacerated wound on forehead alongwith abrasion on finger. Further, as per MLC of Chandan Gupta, there is swelling on right side of his forehead and laceration over upper lip. Further, there are cross cases against each other. There is no CCTV camera obtained by IO whereby covering the incident. Section 110 of BNS entails punishment uptill 7 years.

6. Considering the nature of injury and that punishment prescribed is less than 7 years, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the applicant, hence the bail application is **allowed**. Applicant is admitted to bail on furnishing of personal bond and surety bond of Rs. 25,000/- to the satisfaction of concerned Court/JMFC/Link JMFC/Duty JMFC and subject to the following conditions of bail:.

- (i) The applicant shall under no circumstances leave India without prior permission of the Court concerned.
- (ii) The applicant shall appear before the Court concerned as and when required.
- (iii) The applicant shall not tamper with the evidence during the trial.

- (iv) The applicant shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case.
 - (v) The applicant shall provide his mobile number(s) and keep it operational at all times.
 - (vi) In case of change of residential address and/or mobile number, the same shall be intimated to the Court concerned by way of an affidavit.
7. Accordingly, in the aforesaid terms and conditions, the present application stands disposed off. Nothing mentioned herein shall affect the merits of the case.
