ORDER BELOW EXH. 1

1] This is an application filed by Mamata Ram Nayak for regular bail under Section 439 of Code of Criminal Procedure in respect of Crime No. 297/2018 registered under Section 370(2)(A) (2) of the Indian Penal Code, Section 3, 4, 5, 6 and 7 of PITA Act at Police Station, Faraskhana, Pune.

2] The crime came to be registered on report of P.I. Smt. Arati Khetmalis alleging that on 09/10/2018 they got information about running of brothel in a premises at Budhwar Peth, Pune. Therefore, they arranged for raid. There they found two victim girls. They have stated Applicant confined them and forcefully made them to do prostitution. As such, she lodged the crime.

3] Applicant submits that she has no concern with the alleged crime. In fact, she went the premises to meet her relatives. She was not aware about the running of prostitution business there. Moreover, she is behind the bars since 09/10/2018. Therefore, investigation is completed. Hence, she prays for grant of bail.

4] Learned APP Mr. Satpute appeared for Respondent/State and filed report of Investigation Officer. He, submits that prima facie

material is available against the Applicant. Applicant was running the prostitution center there since last two years and earning money through it. Investigation is in progress. There are chances of tampering and offence is anti-social in nature. Therefore, he prays for rejection of the application.

5] Heard the learned Adv Mr. N. D. Patil for Applicant and the learned APP Mr. Satpute for Respondent/State. Perused the papers.

6] I perused the statement of victim girls. They have clearly alleged that Applicant made them to do the prostitution business and used to earn money through it. Therefore, prima facie material is available against the Applicant. Investigation is in progress. There are chances of tampering. Hence, I prefer to pass following Order.

ORDER

1] The application is rejected.
