

The plaintiff is absent. There is no representation on behalf of the plaintiff.

The order sheet discloses that the case was posted for the plaintiff's evidence on 04.10.2023. Despite granting several adjournments over the past three years, the plaintiff has neither appeared before the Court nor adduced any evidence. On the previous date of hearing, the learned counsel for the plaintiff sought time to lead the plaintiff's evidence. Though no valid grounds were made out for granting an adjournment, in the interest of justice, the prayer was allowed with a clear observation that no further opportunity would be granted and that the plaintiff shall adduce evidence on the next date of hearing.

Despite the said order, today the plaintiff is absent and there is no representation on the plaintiff's behalf. The conduct of the plaintiff clearly indicates that the plaintiff is not interested in prosecuting the suit.

In the circumstances, no useful purpose would be served by keeping

the matter pending. Accordingly, the suit is dismissed for non-prosecution.
