On the LDOH the matter was adjourned for today since the Ld. Counsel for revision petitioner had stated that he was not to place on record a copy of the MLC of the son of the petitioner in relation to the incident of 29.06.2021. In respect of which an application u/s 194 BNSS was also filed for summoning of the concerned doctor alongwith the original record pertaining to the said MLC dated 29.06.2021.

Today a copy of the said MLC is placed on record. A copy of the same also stands supplied to the Ld. Counsel for respondents.

At this stage, the Ld. Counsel for respondents has stated that the respondents does do not dispute the factum of the preparation of the MLC in question and as such they have no objection if the copy of the MLC of the son of the revisionist is considered and taking into account for the purpose of disposal of application of the revision petitioner for seeking leading of additional evidence as well as of his main revision petition.

In view of the abovesaid, since there is no dispute with respect to the authenticity of the MLC in question, there is no need to summon the concerned doctor who prepared the MLC of the son of the petitioner at some "Community Health Center" Village Chokaniya, Mankapur, Ghonda, UP.

Accordingly, the application filed by the petitioner u/s 94 Cr.PC stands disposed off.

Fresh arguments on the application of the petitioner seeking leading of additional evidence as well as main revision petitioner have already heard.
