Today the appellant has deposited one Demand Draft bearing no.016986 dated 08.07.2025 in the sum of Rs.1,60,000, drawn on HDFC Bank in compliance of order dated 17.04.2025 towards the deposit of 20% of the compensation amount.

Let the said Demand Draft be released to respondent against due acknowledgment to be obtained on the order-sheet of last date of hearing. The respondent is also duly made aware that in case of acquittal, he shall be liable to return the said amount to the appellant alongwith interest amount.

At this stage, both the sides have submitted that there are chances of amicable settlement between the parties. In view of the submissions, let the matter be referred to Mediation Center for exploring the possibility of amicable settlement between the parties for 12.07.2025.

In case, the parties failed to arrive at any settlement, case to come up for arguments on the appeal on 11.09.2025.

Both the parties are directed to attend the Mediation Center on 12.07.2025.
