

ANNEXURE**MOTOR ACCIDENT CLAIM PETITION NO.274/2020**

1. Heard learned advocate for the parties. The compromise has been read over and explained to the parties. Perused record of the case. The parties have made satisfaction of this Lok Adalat regarding the compromise of **Rs.1,50,000/- (Rupees One Lakh Fifty Thousands Only)**. The compromise is recorded as per order below Compromise Pursis, Exh.19.
2. The Opponent Insurance company shall deposit the amount of compensation as per compromise within 30 days from the date of this Order.
3. As per the section 21 of the Legal Service Authority Act 1987 where a compromise or settlement has been arrived at, in a Lok Adalat in case referred to it under sub-section (1) of Sec.20, the court fee paid in such case shall be refunded in the manner provided under the Court Fees Act, 1870 (7 of 1870)
4. It is provided in the sec.16 of Court Fees Act.1870 that where the court refers the parties to the suit to any one of the mode of settlement of dispute referred to in section 89 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 (5 of 1908), the claimant shall be entitled to a certificate from the court authorizing him to receive back from the collector, the full amount of the fee paid in respect of such plaint. Hence, no court fee is required to be deducted in this case and if any court fee is paid, the claimant is entitled to get refund of the same.
5. Upon deposit of amount before the Nazir of this Tribunal, it is hereby directed that the entire amount of settlement including the amount of medical bills be paid through RTGS or NEFT mode in the account of the applicant after proper verification.
6. The Insurance Company is directed to deposit the Award amount with interest as per the direction given by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in Writ Petition(s) (Civil) No.534/2020 through RTGS or NEFT mode in the account of Additional District Judge, Surat, the details of account are as under:

The Applicant/Applicants has/have not submitted the details as per the direction given by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in Writ Petition(s) No. 534/2020, therefore, the applicant/ applicants has/have directed to provide the details of PAN Card, Aadhar Card and Saving Bank Account for transfer of compensation as per the direction given by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in Writ Petition(s) (Civil) No. 534/2020.
9. Accordingly, Award be drawn in terms of compromise.
