

Order below Exh.44 in M. A. C. P No. 44 of 2022
(Madhukar Sahebrao Sapkale & Ors. Vs. Bhaiyya Bhagwan Patil &
Ors.)
(CNR No. MHJG-01000-751-2022)

The applicants have filed application under Order 6 Rule 17 of the C.P.C. for adding applicants no.3 and 4 in the caption of applicants.

02) The applicant submitted that he is illiterate. He do not have legal knowledge and therefore, due to over-site at the time of filing petition, he could not add the daughters of the deceased as petitioner in the petition. Therefore, now by this application he has requested to add petitioner no.3 and 4 the proposed petitioners in the petition.

03) The respondent no.3 has no objection to allow the application. Till date the respondent no.1 and 2 have not filed reply.

04) Considering nature of the petition as the petitioner nos.1 and 2 are asking compensation amount because of death of their father. But the deceased had two daughters though the daughters have not cited as a petitioner in the claim. The proposed daughters i.e. petitioner nos.3 and 4 are also the legal heirs/dependents of the deceased, theretofore, it is necessary to add them as petitioner no.3 and 4 in the caption of petition. Accordingly, following order is passed -

ORDER

- 01) The application is allowed.
- 02) The petitioner to carry out amendment within stipulated time, thereafter, issue notice to the proposed petitioner no.3 and 4.
