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ORDER BELOW EXH – 01

Through this application the applicants have prayed to withdraw the compensation amount deposited by State as per the order of Court in L.A.C. 75/2022. The amount as per report of Nazer below Exh.01 Rs.54,933/- (Rupees Fifty Four Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty Three only) is deposited in the Court.

Applicants have filed an affidavit that no such appeal is pending against the order of the Court. State also has no objection. The learned advocate of applicant also assured the Court that no such appeal is pending. Resultantly, I don't find any hurdle, obstacle, impediment or legal embargo to permit the withdrawal of deposited amount on an undertaking. Hence, I reckon to pass this order.

ORDER

1. Application stand allowed.
2. Amount Rs.54,933/- (Rupees Fifty Four Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty Three only) deposited in the Court, be paid online in the bank account of applicant No.2 Gajanan Madhukar Ghongade on written confirmation by all co-applicants and furnishing indemnity bond of like amount.

3. The Applicant No.2 shall submit his bank details, duly certified by the concerned Bank Manager to Assistant Superintendent (Nazir) of this Court forthwith and shall execute Indemnity Bond.
4. Applicant No.2 shall be liable to indemnify and also for legal action for any injury direct or indirect to any person or authority if caused in future by this withdrawal.
5. Assistant Superintendent to comply the order on verification of identity of parties through their advocate and proof of their identification be kept with record.
