1. Heard on the bail application filed by the applicant/ accused.
During arguments Learned counsel for the applicant/accused argued that due to COVID-19, he could not appear before this court and ultimately he was declared proclaimed offender on 8.2.2022. He further argued that absence of the applicant/accused from the court is neither intentional nor willful.He further argued that the applicant/accused was arrested on 17.2.2022 and is in judicial custody since then. He prayed that accused be granted bail.
2. Ld. APP opposed the bail application and argued that the applicant/accused is not entitled for bail as he has misused concession of bail and prayed for dismissal of the bail application.

3. Paper perused. Arguments considered. The applicant/accused was earlier on bail vide order dated 6.10.2018 in this case. The applicant/accused was arrested on 17.2.2022 and he must have learnt lesson for jumping bail. Accordingly, bail application is allowed and applicant/accused is admitted to bail under section 457 and 380 IPC subject to furnishing his bail bond in the sum of Rs.70,000/ with one surety of the like amount. Bonds not furnished. Bail application be attached with the pending challan.
