THE STATE Vs. VIPIN ALIAS PAPPAN

Fresh Vakalatnama filed on behalf of complainant. The same is taken on record.

This is an application seeking grant of anticipatory bail filed u/s 482 on behalf of applicant/accused.

Fresh reply is filed by the IO. The same is taken on record.

As per the reply, the complainant of the case has failed to participate in the TIP proceedings due to which TIP of the applicant has failed. It is further stated as of now apart from the disclosure statement of the applicant/accused and his other coaccused person, there is no other incriminating evidence available on record. As such the custodial interrogation of the applicant/accused is not required at the moment for the purpose of investigation of the present case.

In view of the abovesaid, since the custodial interrogation of the applicant/accused is stated to be not required for the purpose of investigation of present case, the application filed on behalf of applicant/accused stands allowed.

The applicant/accused Vipin @ Pappan is directed to join the investigation and in case of his arrest, following directions shall be

followed :-

*i) In the event of arrest of the applicant/accused, he be released on bail. The amount of bail bond shall be **Rs. 20,000/- with one surety** in like amount to the satisfaction of the concerned IO/SHO.*

ii) The applicant/accused shall cooperate in the investigation at every stage, and shall make his-self available for interrogation by the police as and when required.

iii) The applicant /accused shall provide his latest address to the IO /SHO concerned and in the event of change of address, he shall ensure that he provides his fresh address to IO /SHO concerned immediately.

iv). The applicant/accused shall not leave India without prior permission of the court.

v) The applicant/accused shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him or her from disclosing such facts to the court or to any police officer.

With these conditions, the present anticipatory bail application moved on behalf of applicant/accused Vipin @ Pappan stands disposed off.

It is needless to say that nothing stated herein shall

tantamount to an opinion or expression of the Court on the merits of the case.

Copy of this order be given dasti to the parties.

Application stands disposed off accordingly.
