Since, Sh. Tarun Shamra, Ld. Counsel for the appellant stated that due to non-payment of his fees by the appellant he does not want to pursue the present case on behalf of the appellant as his Ld. Counsel, he stands discharged from the present case as counsel for appellant at his request. The Ld. Counsel is also at liberty to pursue his legal remedy for the recovery of his professional fee.

At this stage, in view of submissions made on the LDOH, today it is again stated by the parties that they are ready to amicably settle the present matter and are also willing to make their separate statements before the court regarding the terms and condition of the agreed settlement.

In view of submissions, separate statements of both the sides regarding the agreed settlement are recorded in the court.

As per the settlement, the appellant has agreed to pay a total sum of Rs. 12 lacs towards the full and final settlement of dispute which shall be paid in four installments as mentioned in her separate statements. It is further agreed that in case of any default, the appellant shall also be liable to pay a penalty amount of Rs. 1 lac on each default.

It is needless to mention here that the amount of Rs. 91,000/- already paid by the appellant to the respondent shall also be

adjusted in the total amount and since both the sides have also agreed, the same shall be adjusted only in the last installment of the settlement amount.

In view of the statement of the parties, since they have already settled their dispute as per the terms and conditions disclosed in their statements, the present appeal stands disposed off as settled/compounded between the parties and appellant stands acquitted for commission of offence u/sec. 138 NI Act.

The appeal in hand accordingly stands disposed off.
