Fresh suit is received by way of assignment. It be checked and registered.

Present: Ld. Counsel for plaintiff.

Plaintiff is before this court seeking possession of the entire property left by her father/late Tara Chand. Tara Chand died in 2025 and left behind two daughters i.e. plaintiff and one Aarti as his only class-I legal heirs. Aarti was married to one Sandeep/defendant but has no children. Aarti died in 2026 and it is the case of the plaintiff that on her death the property which was inherited by Aarti (from Tara Chand on his death in 2025) would revert back to plaintiff and therefore, plaintiff becomes the sole owner of the entire property.

Premised on the aforesaid contention, plaintiff is before this court seeking declaration of ownership, possession of the entire property along with other injunctive reliefs.

Plaintiff has relied upon the judgment of **Arunachala Gounder (Dead) by LRs vs. Ponnusamy and ors., Civil Appeal No. 6659 of 2011, DOD: 20.01.2022.**

Considering the averments made in the plaint, plaintiff is called upon to clarify that if Aarti had inherited 50% share from Tara Chand and she herself left behind her husband/Sandeep as class-I legal heir, how could that 50% share revert back to the plaintiff on the death of Aarti. Plaintiff seeks time to clarify on this aspect.
