

BAIL MATTERS 477/2026
THE STATE Vs. "K"

1. This is the bail application filed on behalf of the applicant/accused 'K'.
2. It is submitted that applicant is 19 years of age. She is student of 1st year. In the FIR, it is not mentioned that applicant was involved in the crime. They all were friends who had gone to the restaurant and she had no role to play in the commission of crime. It is also submitted that in the supplementary statement of Mayank, no specific role is attributed to her.
3. On the other hand, Ld. Addl. PP duly assisted by IO submits that there is CCTV footage wherein accused Yash could be seen coming out with applicant and firing at the injured. Further, it is applicant who had called Mayank at the restaurant, CDR of applicant is on record.
4. I have heard both the sides and gone through the record.
5. CCTV footage is played in the Court which is taken from camera installed outside the restaurant. It is seen in the footage that Mayank comes out of the restaurant alongwith Arpit, he starts a bike. While Mayank was sitting on bike and Arpit was

standing near bike, suddenly accused Yash comes out of the restaurant and applicant is behind him. He fires at Mayank thereafter Mayank runs away on bike. But bullet hits him on arm. The perusal of CCTV footages shows that applicant is actually trying to stop accused Yash which is prima facie against the case of prosecution.

6. Further, she is not named in the FIR. Further, in the supplementary statement of Mayank recorded on 25.05.2026, no specific role is attributed to applicant, it is generally mentioned that all three accused had made a conspiracy in order to commit the offence.

7. In the overall circumstances of the case including CCTV footage, the application is **allowed**. Applicant is admitted to bail on furnishing of personal bond and surety bond of Rs. 25,000/- to the satisfaction of concerned Court/JMFC/Link JMFC/Duty JMFC and subject to the following conditions of bail:.

- (i) The applicant shall under no circumstances leave India without prior permission of the Court concerned.
- (ii) The applicant shall appear before the Court concerned as and when required.
- (iii) The applicant shall not tamper with the evidence during the trial.
- (iv) The applicant shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case.

- (v) The applicant shall provide her mobile number(s) and keep it operational at all times.
- (vi) In case of change of residential address and/or mobile number, the same shall be intimated to the Court concerned by way of an affidavit.

8. Accordingly, in the aforesaid terms and conditions, the present application stands disposed off. Nothing mentioned herein shall affect the merits of the case.
