An application under section 151 of the Code of Civil Procedure moved on behalf of defendant for recalling of order dated 01.04.2025 whereby the right of defendant to cross-examine the plaintiff was closed, is pending adjudication.

Reply to the abovesaid application alongwith evidence by way of affidavit of PW2 has been filed. Copy supplied.

Perusal of the order-sheet reveals that on 01.04.2025, the right of the defendant to cross-examine the plaintiff was closed by Court order. In view of the reasons mentioned in the present application, one last and final opportunity is granted to the defendant to cross-examine the plaintiff subject to cost of Rs. 2,000/- to be paid by the defendant to the plaintiff on the next date of hearing.
