Order:-

Applicants/accused have filed regular bail application on the grounds that they are innocent and have been falsely implicated in the present case. No recovery has been effected from the applicants/accused. They are in custody since 23.11.2019. Conclusion of trial will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the applicants/accused in custody. So, applicants/accused be released on bail.

2. Notice served upon the State and Sh. Jagjit Singh Additional Public Prosecutor has appeared on behalf of the State. Record received.

3. I have heard the arguments and gone through the file carefully. As per the case of prosecution, applicants/accused were arrested while travelling a vehicle i.e. Canter containing 100 boxes (total 1200 bottles) of country made liquor meant for sale in Chandigarh UT only. Ld.APP for the State argued that huge quantity i.e. 1200 bottles of country made liquor has been recovered from the applicants/accused. So, applicants/accused be not released on bail. Perusal of the file shows that applicants/accused are in custody for last about 4 months. Trial is yet to commence and it will take sufficient time in conclusion of trial. No useful purpose will be served by detaining applicants/accused in custody. Accordingly, present

bail application is hereby allowed and applicants/accused are ordered to be released on bail, subject to furnishing of bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate and also subject to furnishing complete details of their Pan Card, Adhar Card, Bank Account and complete residential address. File be consigned to the record room.
