1. Today, matter is fixed for consideration on regular bail application under Section 483 BNS for seeking bail moved on behalf of accused/applicant.
2. Reply filed on behalf of IO. Same is taken on record.
3. It is submitted by IO that complaint of complainant Gurpreet Singh on 11.05.2026 regarding theft of water meter from his taxi stand at NFC was received by way of e-FIR. Subsequently, investigation ensued. During investigation, one accused Mahesh S/o Raju was arrested, who disclosed regarding the fact that stolen water meter and water motor was sold to accused/applicant Rahimuddin S/o Hanif. Subsequently, the search was conducted and stolen property was recovered from the godown of accused/applicant. Accused/applicant was apprehended on 28.05.2026.
4. It is argued on behalf of accused that he is 60 years of age and works as a kabadi and was unaware that the articles received by him was stolen property. He has argued that the accused is in JC since 28.05.2026 and be granted bail.
5. Ld. Addl. PP for State has argued that the accused/applicant had committed the offence in connivance with co-accused and the bail application of the accused/applicant was already rejected by Ld. ACJM on 01.06.2026 and the accused is not entitled for bail.
6. Submissions heard. Record perused.

7. In the present matter the allegations against accused/applicant are pertaining to receiving stolen property. The alleged property has already been recovered. Investigation qua the accused/applicant is already complete and no further custodial investigation is required. Considering the aforesaid factual matrix and nature of offence, the period of detention of applicant/ accused for the alleged offence and also other circumstances of this case, no purpose will be served by keeping applicant/accused in custody. **In these circumstances, applicant/ accused Rahimuddin S/o Hanif, is admitted to bail on his furnishing personal bond and surety bond in the sum of Rs.10,000/- with one surety of like amount, subject to the satisfaction of concerned Court/ Ld. Link JMFC/ Ld. Duty JMFC.**

The bail is also subjected to following conditions :-

1. Accused will not threaten complainant and other prosecution witnesses.
2. Accused will not tamper with evidence collected by police.
3. Accused will not repeat the offence in future.
4. Accused will keep his mobile phone in switch on mode till the adjudication of the case and will furnish it in the personal bond. Similarly, surety will also keep his mobile phone in switch on mode till the adjudication of the case.
