It is submitted by Ld. Counsel for applicant/accused that two other co-accused namely Ravi Gupta and Aman are already on bail. The role of co-accused Bobby is also same. There is no recovery from him. There is no CCTV footage of the incident. The allegations are against accused Shivansh @ Golu for commission of crime.

It is submitted by Ld. Additional PP for the state duly assisted by the IO that all five accused persons were involved in the commission of crime.

I have heard both sides and gone through the case.

In the present case, the role of applicant/accused Bobby is same as that of other co-accused namely Ravi Gupta and Aman.

In the FIR, it is specifically mentioned that accused Shivansh @ Golu stabbed in the stomach of injured with the knife. There is no specific allegation against applicant/accused Bobby as well. There is no recovery from him and other two co-accused persons namely Ravi Gupta and Aman are already on bail. The role of present applicant/accused Bobby is same as that of other co-accused namely Ravi Gupta and Aman who are on bail.

In view of the above, on the ground of parity, the **applicant/accused Bobby** is also admitted to bail. The application is **allowed**. Applicant is admitted to bail on furnishing of personal bond

and surety bond of Rs. 25,000/- to the satisfaction of concerned Court/JMFC/Link JMFC/Duty JMFC and subject to the following conditions of bail:.

- (i) The applicant shall under no circumstances leave India without prior permission of the Court concerned.
- (ii) The applicant shall appear before the Court concerned as and when required.
- (iii) The applicant shall not tamper with the evidence during the trial.
- (iv) The applicant shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case.
- (v) The applicant shall provide his mobile number(s) and keep it operational at all times.
- (vi) In case of change of residential address and/or mobile number, the same shall be intimated to the Court concerned by way of an affidavit.

Accordingly, in the aforesaid terms and conditions, the present application stands disposed off. Nothing mentioned herein shall affect the merits of the case.
