Arguments on bail application heard.

Record perused.

It is submitted by Ld. Counsel for the applicant that applicant has been falsely implicated in the present case by the police officials at the instance of complainant. It is further submitted that applicant has been languishing in jail since 29.05.2022. It is further submitted that applicant is only sole bread earner of his family consisting of old aged parents. That charge sheet has been filed and applicant is no more required for the purpose of any investigation. It is further submitted that applicant is innocent. He further prays for grant of bail to applicant/accused.

On the other hand, bail application has been vehemently opposed by Ld. Addl. PP for the State arguing that allegations against the applicant are serious in nature.

The allegations against the applicant are that on

09.05.2022 at about 12.05 AM applicant along with co-accused voluntarily beaten Aman and also caused injury on his head by hitting danda blows.

Perusal of the record reveals that matter is at initial stage and only charge has been framed. Statement of material witnesses are yet to be recorded. If the applicant is admitted on bail at this stage, there is every likelihood that he may temper with prosecution evidence. The allegations against the applicant are grave and serious in nature.

Keeping in view the totality of facts and circumstances of the case, no ground is made out for the indulgence of this court at this stage. Bail application accordingly stands dismissed.
