State Vs. Afzal Ahmed @ Chotte & Ors.

Accused Afzal Ahmed @ Chotte on interim bail vide order dt. 09.08.19 in person.
Remaining two accused produced from JC.
Sh. S. Mansoori, Advocate for accused Afzal Ahmad @ Chotte.
Sh. Manish Kumar Singh, Advocate for remaining two accused.
IO Insp. Tarkeshwar Singh is also present today.

An application seeking release of two mobile phones as articles of jamatalashi moved by applicant/accused Mohd. Afzal, is listed for hearing today.

IO has pointed out that said mobile phones were not recovered during personal search of applicant/accused and same are part of the case property seized during investigation.

At this stage, counsel for applicant/accused seeks permission to withdraw the application. His statement in this regard has been obtained on application itself.

In view of above, the said application is dismissed as withdrawn.

An application seeking direction to produce footage of CCTV camera installed at ATM of ICICI Bank, Yamuna Vihar Branch, moved on behalf of accused Afzal Ahmed, is also listed for hearing today.

Counsel for applicant/accused has placed on record copy of application moved by one Avinash Sharma with concerned Manager of said bank and reply thereto received on e-mail from concerned Branch Manager alongwith images provided by Bank Authority, in support of his submission that copy of reply filed by IO alongwith his report that images have not been provided by the Bank Authority on the pretext of error in Hard Disk Drive, is apparently incorrect.

Copies of reply and images have been supplied to IO, who seeks time to get the same verified from the Bank Authority and to take appropriate action, if so required in accordance with law and to submit the report before the Court. The pending applications are directed to be listed for hearing on 03.09.2019 at 12:30 pm. IO is directed to file the report on said date and time.

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IO has informed that three more accused have already been arrested in this case and proclamation u/s 82 CrPC has already been issued against one more accused. He seeks 15 days time to file supplementary chargesheet in this case. He is directed to expedite the filing of supplementary chargesheet in this case and to ensure that supplementary chargesheet is filed at the earliest and preferably by next date.

Put up on 27.09.2019 for awaiting supplementary chargesheet as well as for consideration of charge. IO is bound down for next date.
