It is submitted by the accused that due to his financial condition he is not in a position to engage a counsel in the instant matter. Accordingly, he is requested to provide legal aid.

Dy. LADC Sh. Sanjay Hooda is present in the court. He is requested to assist the accused. Accordingly, bail application is filed by Ld. Dy. LADC.

Submissions of Ld. Dy. LADC heard.

The present case is U/S 135 of the Electricity Act. The case is based upon the documentary evidence. Trial of this case will take its own time. Considering all these facts, the accused is admitted on bail on furnishing the personal bond and the surety bond of Rs. 20,000/-. **Personal bond has been furnished and the same is hereby accepted till the next date of hearing.**

Ld. Dy. LADC seeks some time to furnish the bail bond.

The documents have been supplied to Ld. Dy. LADC. Ld. Dy. LADC has gone through the documents. Same are complete.

Submissions on framing of notice heard.

It is submitted by the Ld. Dy. LADC for the accused that accused has been falsely implicated in the instant matter and no offence is made out against him.

Per contra, it is submitted by complainant company that prima faice offence under Section 135 of Electricity Act is made out against the accused as the sufficient material is on record against the accused.

As per Section 154 (3) of the Electricity Act, 2003, the special court may, notwithstanding anything contained in sub-section (1) of section 260 or section 262 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, try the offence referred to in (sections 135 to 140 and section 150) in a summary way in accordance with the procedure prescribed in the said Code and the provisions of section 263 to 265 of the said Code shall, so far as may be, apply to such trial.

Accordingly, the notice u/s. 135 Electricity Act is framed qua the accused. He pleads not guilty and claims trial.

At this stage, it is submitted by the accused that he is ready and willing to settle the present matter with the complainant company and matter may be referred in the Lok Adalat.

In view of the, let the matter be placed before the Lok Adalat, which is going to be held on **14.12.2024**.

In case of no settlement, matter is listed for PE on **25.01.2025**.
