4. Whether the Defendant No.9 proves that she is the bonafide purchaser of property vide Sale Deed dated 09.09.2019?
5. Whether the Defendant No.12 prove that he is a bonafide purchaser of Suit Schedule Properties for a valuable consideration?
6. Whether the Defendants prove that the suit is bad for partial partition?

7. Whether the Defendants further prove that the suit is bad for non-joinder of necessary parties to the suit?
8. Whether the Plaintiffs are entitled for 2/5th share in the Suit Schedule Properties?
9. What order or decree?
