1. Arguments on the bail application of accused Rohit Sharma have been heard.
2. It is argued on behalf of Ld. Counsel for accused that applicant is in judicial custody for the last two years. He is innocent and has been falsely implicated in the present matter. He is a young man aged 25 years having family responsibilities. It is further argued that co-accused have already been admitted to bail, therefore, he be also admitted to bail.
3. On the other hand, Ld. Addl. PP for the State has opposed the bail application stating that the allegations against the accused are serious in nature and the role of co-accused, who have been enlarged on bail, is different from him. Both the victims have deposed against him before the court and have supported the prosecution case to the hilt. They have deposed that applicant had stabbed the victim Sachin. The role of co-accused was to exhort him. It was applicant who had stabbed victim on his abdomen with sharp cutter. After receiving injury, his intestine is seen out of his abdomen. Nature of injury was dangerous. Had he not received immediate medical treatment, he was sure to die. The doctors saved his life after performing a major emergency surgery. He also developed certain post surgery complications as well. He

remained hospitalized for several days on several occasions. He was not well even when he was examined in the court.

4. Public witness Manish Chauhan, other victim, had taken him to hospital after tying his shirt around his waist to prevent further loss of blood.

5. Considering the conduct of the applicant in committing dacoity with the victim along with other co-accused and leaving him to die on road after stabbing him, he is not entitled to grant of bail. Accordingly, bail application of accused is dismissed.

6. Copy of this order be given dasti to Ld. Counsel for accused/applicant as prayed for.
