ORDER BELOW EXH. 1

Applicant Ravi Sadashiv Bhandolkar seeks to be released on bail in the event of his arrest in C.R.No. 294/2014 lodged u/s. 376, 313, 323, 504, 34 of Indian Penal Code and u/s. 3, 4, 5 and 6 of Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, with Kondhwa Police Station.

2- It is the case of the prosecution that the victim filed FIR with the said Police Station. She was 17 years of age and one Yogesh Kantilal Shinde, aged 19 years was residing near her house; they got to know each other and had love affair and he used to visit her when nobody was at her house and they had physical relations. It is alleged that thereafter he used to call her and had forcible sexual intercourse with her under the promise of marriage and when she conceived, he insisted her to abort the child. The family members of Yogesh also assured her about the same. However, thereafter the marriage was avoided and accordingly, offence was registered against Yogesh, his parents, maternal uncle, maternal aunt, alleging that they helped Yogesh, and abused & beat her.

3- Present applicant is the maternal uncle against whom, it is alleged that he insisted on getting the victim aborted. Chargesheet was filed against the other accused and the case is committed to this Court and the same is part-heard. The present applicant is shown as absconding in the matter.

4- State has filed report. It has been contended that the applicant is referred to as 'Ravi Mama' in the FIR.

5- Considering the allegations against the applicant and overall nature of the proceedings, in my view, custodial interrogation of the applicant would not be necessary. However, it would be necessary for him to attend the concerned Police Station so that police can take appropriate steps in accordance with law. In such circumstances, I pass following order :

ORDER

- (1) Application is allowed.
- (2) In the event of arrest of applicant - Ravi Sadashiv Bhandolkar, in connection with C.R.No. 294/2014 lodged u/s. 376, 313, 323, 504, 34 of Indian Penal Code and u/s. 3, 4, 5 and 6 of Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, with Kondhwa Police Station, he be released on his executing P. R. Bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand only) with one or two sureties in like amount.
- (3) Applicant shall attend Kondhwa Police Station on 10th December 2018, and thereafter on every Wednesday and Friday for one month.
