

ORDER BELOW EXH.1 IN MACP NO. 279 OF 2017.

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1. The parties i.e. the clalmant and the Insurance Company have submitted compromise Pursis as the mater has been amicably settled between them for a sum of Rs. 9,51,000/- as full and final compensation. The same is read-over and explained to the parties and they have voluntarily accepted the same. I am also satisfied that, it is both legal and within the perview of subject matter of the Claim Pettition and also in the interest of clalmant. The compromise is, therefore recorded in exercise of the power under Order 23 of the Civil Precedure Code and following order is passed.

:- ORDER :-

1. The Respondents No. 4 - Insurance Company shall pay the compromise amount **within the period of 3 months** from the date of compromise, failing which the compromise amount shall carry the simple rate @ 9% p.a. from the date of the compromise.
2. Both the parties shall bear their own cost. If the petitioner has deposited the Court fees, then in that case, certificate for refund of Court fees be issued in the name of the petitioner.
3. Order regarding payment and investment of the compensation amount shall be made at the time of disbursement of the amount.
4. Award be drawn accordingly.
