ORDER BELOW EXH-1

The plaintiff and his advocate are absent though called repeatedly. Perused the record. Perusal of the record shows that, the present suit is fixed for evidence. The plaintiff has constantly remained absent to take necessary steps and to proceed with the suit.

02. In spite of sufficient opportunity, the plaintiff had failed to take necessary steps to proceed with the suit. By order dated 05/02/2024 below Exh. 1 the matter was posted for dismissal order. Surprising to note even after having the knowledge about the said order today also the plaintiff and his advocate had remained absent.

03. Time and again the Hon'ble High Court used to issue directions in respect of disposal of stale and ineffective cases. The present suit is pending for long period without progress and thus falls in the category of stale and ineffective cases.

04. Considering the above situation, and with the above discussion, I am of the view that, the plaintiff is no more interested in proceeding further with the suit. The present suit is liable to be dismissed. Hence, I pass the following order.

- 01.** Regular Civil Suit No. 375/2022 is dismissed in default for non prosecution.
- 02.** Case is accordingly disposed of.
- 03.** Plaintiff to bear his own costs.
