

Aman Kumar Vs. State of Pb.

Heard on application for bail, which has been filed on behalf of accused in FIR No. 161 Dated 22.06.2022 registered at P.S. City-I, Abohar, under section 174-A IPC on the ground that applicant/accused has not received any summon, R.C. warrants of the court, nor he earlier came present before the court. It has been further averred that applicant is law abide citizen of India and never remained entangle in any anti-social or criminal activity throughout of his life. It has been further stated that applicant/accused will not temper with the prosecution evidence if the bail is granted. It has been further stated that applicant/accused undertake to appear in this court on each and every date of hearing. The accused/applicant is in custody since 13.02.2024 and prayed that conclusion of trial will take time, so accused be released on bail.

2. Upon notice, Ld. APP for State did not intend to file reply to the present application and opposed the same on the grounds of gravity of offence.

3. From the perusal of the case file it reveals that FIR against the accused was registered U/s 174-A of IPC as he was declared P.O in case titled as "Sahyog Credit Cooperative Society Vs. Aman Kumar" having CIS No. NACT/1721/2019 registered against him U/s 138 of Negotiable Instrument Act. The accused/ applicant is under detention since the date of his arrest i.e. 13.02.2024 and accused was remanded to judicial custody on request of prosecution itself. Trial of the case will take time and no useful purpose would be served by keeping the accused in judicial custody for indefinite period. Therefore, without commenting upon the merits of the case, accused is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bond in the sum of Rs. 20,000/- with one surety in the like amount, subject to following conditions:-

- 1) He shall not commit similar type of offence.
- 2) He shall not induce or threat witnesses of the case and shall not tamper with evidence of the case.
- 3) He shall come present in the court on each and every date.

Bail bonds and surety bonds not furnished. Present papers be attached with main file. Copy of this order be send to accused through concerned Jail Superintendent. Ahlmad is directed to put file after one month, if bail bonds are not furnished till then.
